

Hiking and Climbing in Peru

Keith Daellenbach and his family traveled to Peru, South America for an adventure in July 2014. Keith and his father Chuck, attempted a climb of Nevado Pisco Oeste (18,872 ft.) in Peru's Cordillera Blanca, reaching high camp at 16,200 ft. surrounded by spectacular 6,000 m peaks. While they were ultimately unable to reach the summit, they had a fantastic time exploring the high Andes together. Before the climb his whole family, which also included his wife Amy, son Micah, and mother Faye, shared in the adventure: hiking four days on the 23 mile Inca Trail into Machu Picchu with a Peruvian guide, enjoying a home stay in the remote village of Ccamahuara near Cusco, and exploring of the Spanish colonial capital, Lima, at the edge of the Pacific Ocean. By sharing their lives, land, food, and culture, their new Peruvian friends taught the Daellenbach family something about themselves that they will always treasure. Viva Peru!
